## **VIA DON VENDER**

The headquarters houses the Erasmus Office, the Academy Management, the Deputy Management, the Orientation Office, and the Student Secretariat. It is equipped with functional laboratories for the courses it welcomes, such as a laying room, a control room, a podcast room, and an audio mixing room. In addition, workshops, performances and multidisciplinary meetings are held every year in its auditorium for LABA students and the wider public.

## **VIA PRIVATA**

Located near the modern and functional south entrance of the city train station, this headquarter, in addition to hosting the administrative department of the Academy, the DSU Office and the General Secretariat, also houses a printing laboratory with a plotter.

## **VIA CEFALONIA**

The headquarters in via Cefalonia, located in front of the Bresciadue metro stop and adjacent to Confindustria Brescia, is part of the city sector that houses the main structures of the tertiary sector including the main offices of Telecom Italia, UBI Banca, and the headquarters of the Crystal Palace, symbol of the business district.

Here, at the center of an urban area that is also characterized by its particular vocation to "green" (from Gallo park to Tarello park), is housed the Placement Office as well as the room for 3D printing, laser cutting and experimental research on the metaverse.

### *academic calendar*

Beginning of academic year: Monday **20th October 2025**

End (exams included) **3rd July 2026** (for all students).

Erasmus students should arrive **on time** and stay in LABA **until the end of exams session**, otherwise a complete transcript of records will not be guaranteed.

**\*Please note that after the end of the courses and before the beginning of exam sessions (of each semester) there will be 2/3 weeks of lessons' recovery. It is mandatory to attend them as well!**

### *lessons*

Lesson time usually goes Monday to Friday, from 08:30 a.m. until 07:00 p.m.

Attendance to lessons is **mandatory** (at least 80%) of every single course.

Please note that absences can only be justified by sending a medical certification at [erasmus@laba.edu](mailto:erasmus@laba.edu).

***Lessons will only be in presence!***

Lessons are taken in **Italian**, so the Academy strongly advises Erasmus+ students to take Italian courses before coming.

We do not expect our exchange students to speak fluent Italian;

They'll be mostly integrated in **practical courses**, where teachers may provide individual guidance to international students in English, or switch the language of group work to English when feasible.

## *fact sheet*

### *COURSES*

There are two type of courses:

*Semestral* and *annual* ones.

For one-semester Erasmus students: please keep in mind that, in case you're attending an annual course, you'll be necessarily evaluated on half of the Programme.

*It is strongly recommended to inform the professors about the duration of your stay at the beginning of their course.*

During the first two weeks after your arrival, attendance is not mandatory.

You are free to attend any courses *within your department* to explore and decide which ones best fit your Learning Agreement and help you reach the required ECTS.

After this period, you will need to finalize your course selection and communicate it to me. I will provide you with a table listing courses, professors, and ECTS to assist you in completing your Learning Agreement (OLA) for your home university.

Please ensure your Learning Agreement is ready within two weeks, as it is necessary to be eligible for exams.

*It is strongly advised to remain in your own department and to choose a single class to join. If, by doing so, you can't reach the required ects, you can freely add some other year's subjects - always from the same department.*

***NB Credits of annual courses, if you just attend one semester, MUST BE HALVED.***

## *fact sheet*

### *exams*

Exams are mostly *oral/practical*.

*Erasmus students are **not listed** in the portal, as they are already considered registered for exams.*

*You will not need to register like other students, but you must **inform your professor** that you intend to take their exam at the end of the semester or academic year.*

*It will be up to the professor to decide how and when to evaluate you.*

You will receive an institutional e-mail address:  
all the important notices (delays, cancelled lessons...) will be communicated through it, please stay updated!

### *final evaluation*

You will receive an immediate evaluation after showing and explaining your final projects (which you've been working on during the whole course period).

Your evaluation will be recorded in your *libretto*, a small booklet that ***you must bring with you to all exam sessions***.

At the end of your mobility, your Professors will send to the erasmus office the grades you received.

You'll be also asked to scan your libretto and send it to [erasmus@laba.edu](mailto:erasmus@laba.edu).

Finally, your Transcript of Records will be sent to you by e-mail, together with your Attendance Certificate.

### *relevant informations*

- The Academy is not accepting applications for the Bachelor's degrees in Audiovisual Film and Multimedia Scenography and Dramatic Performing Arts for the second semester.
- The Academy is not accepting applications for the Master's degree in Cinema and Audiovisual for the second semester.
- It is possible to attend the 'Tecniche di Modellazione Digitale' course in the Design department only for students on annual mobility.
